Please advise on approximately how many procurement transactions you undertook in the past 12 months and we can estimate a range of fees from there. The fees are related to volume (number of vendors checked) and the more you- verify, the lower the price etc.

1. We make the information available by WeTransfer
2. We set up a Microsoft Teams site that your nominated persons could access files from. This will require your team members to use Microsoft Authenticator to access our site
3. We make files available on our sftp server and supply your team members with a secure encrypted key where they can use any file transfer program to log in and down load the files.
