Kings Mission Primary School

On Monday the 6th of June we visited Kings Mission Primary School in the BCMM municipal area. It is a rural school with an admission of not more than 250 learners. It is a rural school on the outskirts of East London.

The collections from the Water Initiative amounted to R11 630. The collections were used to buy school uniform for learners. The learners who were beneficiaries had been selected through the following manner:

We asked the principal to liaise with the teachers in her school to compile a listing of students who did

not have proper or sufficient school attire. Also in our request for information we asked them to specify the exact item of uniform and the size required for each learner who they had identified as needing uniform.

After we obtained the list we went to Transkie Uniforms a uniform retailer in East London downtown and bought uniforms as per the list we had obtained.

We then went to the school and delivered the uniforms, the school had an extended assembly in anticipation of our visit. They had invited the parents of all the children

who would receive articles of uniform on the day.

After a few speakers addressed us expressing their gratitude we then proceeded to hand over the uniforms. We were then invited to have drinks at cookies (Choice Assorted), which had been prepared for us at the staff room.

We left the school at mid-morning and when I got to my work station I had an email inbox from the school expressing their gratitude.
